

Spring Term 1: Year 6

English

Our focus will be on writing suspense stories. We will look at the elements that make up a good suspense story and analyse styles of writing that model how to create suspense well. Grammar will focus on: subordinating clauses and conjunctions, colons and semi-colons, passive and active voice, the verb – to be and apostrophes for singular and plural possession. We will continue to practice spelling homophones, as well as revisiting a number of spelling conventions previously taught over Key Stage 2.

Geography

We will be finding out what a biome is and using world maps to locate biome types around the world. We will look at animals and vegetation that are found in specific biomes. We will also cover: lines of latitude and longitude, tropics of cancer and Capricorn and time zones. We will be researching and comparing the arctic circle and Antarctica, as well as recapping on how adaptation allows for plants and animals to survive in these hostile environments. Later on, we will find out about the people who live in the arctic circle and the aurora borealis.
