Attendance;

Attendance at school is compulsory. Holidays should not be booked or taken during term time. Schools cannot authorise any holidays taken during term time. The school attendance Policy can be found on the attendance section of our school website.

So far this year we are at 95.1% attendance across the school. Our persistent Absentees are 87% which equates to 24 pupils in the school. Please ensure you call school each day if your child is ill. If we do not hear from parents absences are marked as unauthorised.

We are reviewing our reward system for attendance. In the past we have given rewards and this had proved difficult for some children to achieve a 100% attendance award due to medical appointments etc. However, as a drive to look at how we can improve we would like your views. If you have any thoughts about how we could reward good attendance please get in touch.

Uniform:

Please label every item of your child's uniform. If they lose an item of uniform and it is not found in the classroom or cloakroom, we have a lost property box near the office. Children can come and look in the box at playtime or lunch time, or parents can look before or after school.

<u>PE Kits Key Stage 2</u>: Please can you ensure that children come to school in the appropriate PE attire. We do not have School PE tracksuits to purchase as they are too expensive; it is much more reasonable to purchase black/navy leggings or tracksuit bottoms from Amazon/Asda/Tesco. Please also ensure that your child wears the school PE T- shirt and the School hoody.

<u>Staying Safe</u> is paramount and we have a duty of care to ensure that all our children stay safe both inside school and outside school. As we know Safeguarding is everybody's business.

A reminder that gates will remain closed on the playground until 8.30am.

<u>Staying Healthy:</u> Hooray the sun is beginning to show and it is warming up. We put up the sun shades on the playground this week. Please ensure your child has a hat in school and comes to school with sun screen on to help protect them. We encourage the children to drink regularly during the day so they do not dehydrate.
